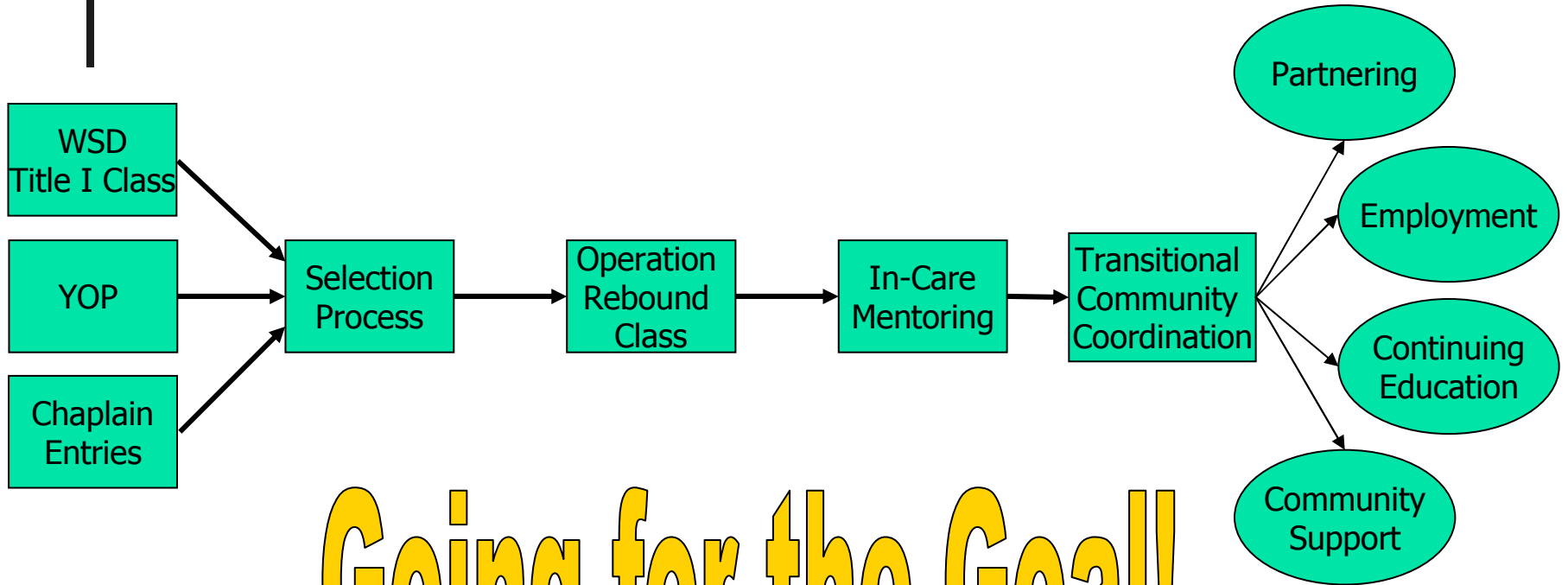

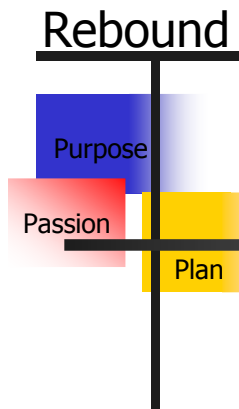

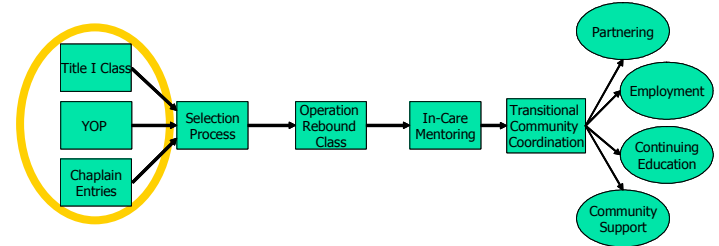
# Program Flow

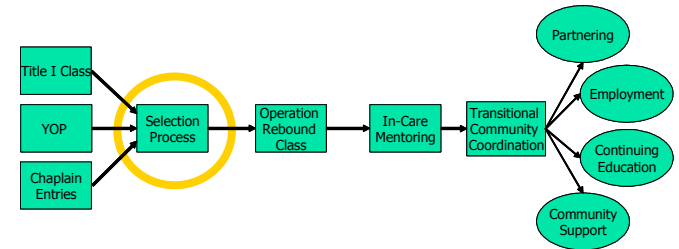

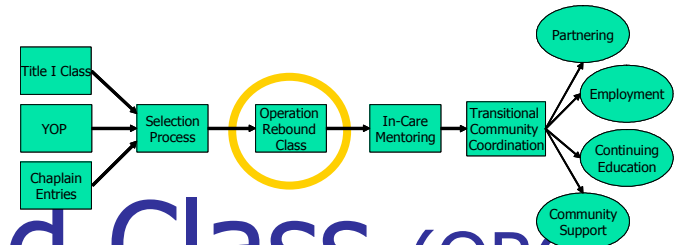

- Training Instructors

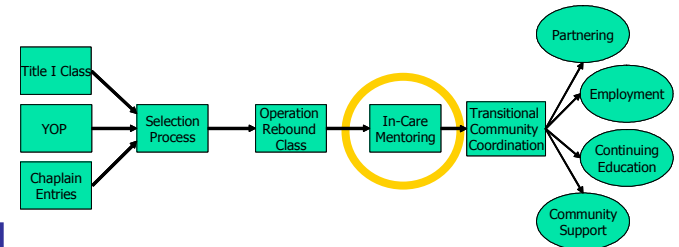

# In-Care Mentoring



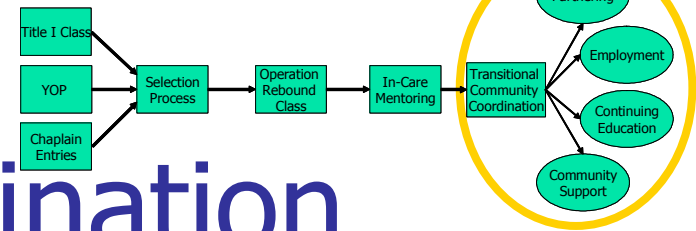
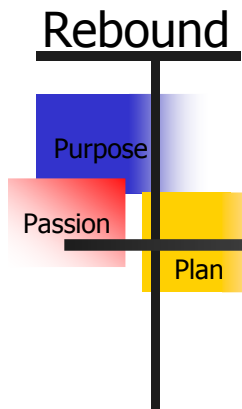
## ■ Purpose

- Establish a “trusting relationship” with the participant
- Work with mentee to develop a personal reentry transitional plan
- Reinforce life skills learned in the ORC

## ■ Roles

- Mentor Coordinator
- In-Care Mentors

# Transitional Community Coordination



## ■ Purpose

- Facilitates the transition process to help ensure a successful integration back into society.
- Work with mentee to refine a personal transitional plan
  - Continuation of the mentoring process by providing encouragement, guidance and identifying community resources.

- Partner Role (out-care mentoring)

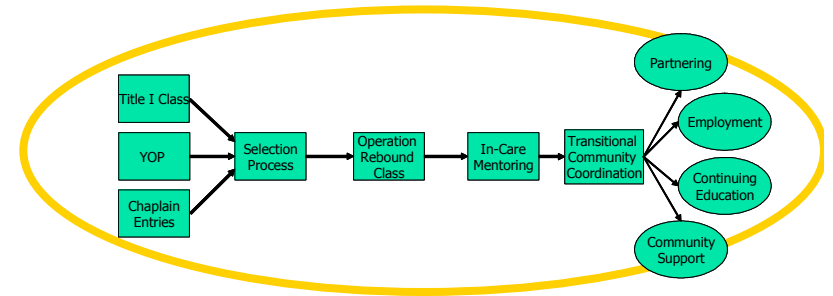
